

Math Lesson Plan: Butterflies

Students will be able to write and compare numbers from 1 to 10.

Materials Needed:

- Construction paper divided into sections labeled 1-10
- Glue
- Book "Ten Magic Butterflies" by Danic McKellar

Subject Math:

Number and Counting

Number writing and qualifying

1. Read: "Ten Magic Butterflies" by Danic McKellar, together, pausing to count butterflies on each page.
2. Each student receives construction paper divided into sections labeled 1-10, along with a set of butterfly cutouts.
3. Students glue the correct number of butterflies in each section to match the numeral.
4. For younger students, use only numbers 1-5; for advanced students, extend to 1-20.
5. The teacher asks questions like, "Which section has more butterflies?" or "How many butterflies are in section 3?"
6. End with a group discussion: "What did you notice about the numbers? Which section had the most butterflies?"
